

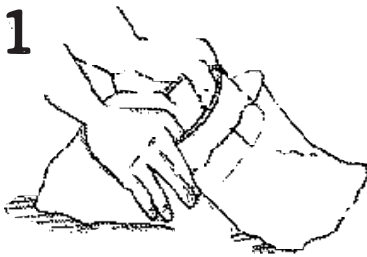
# Planting Trees to Hold Back the Desert
