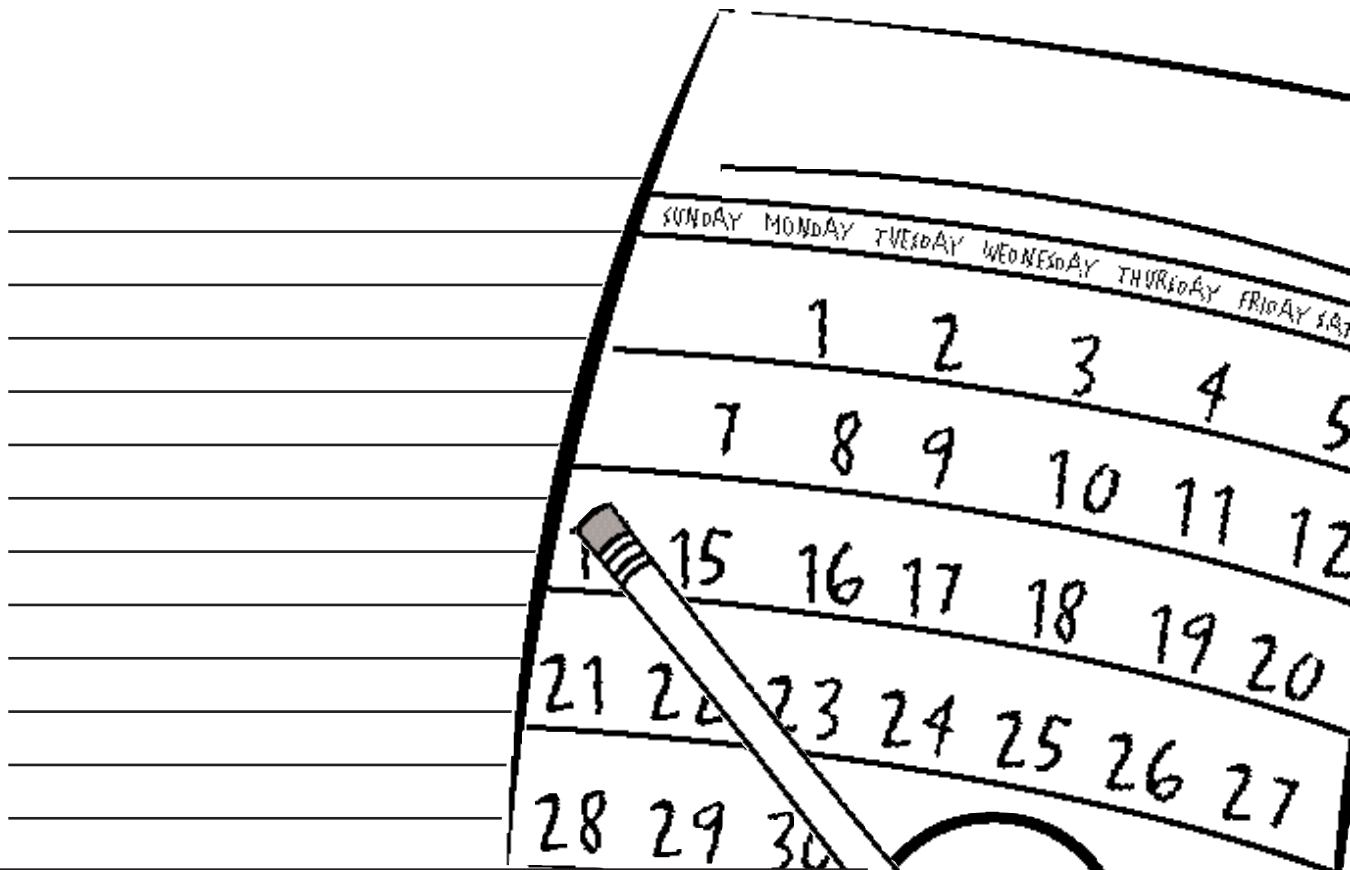


# Take Action Around the World

World Food Day	October 16
Universal Children’s Day	November 20
